

Destination will be on the right 0.2 mi

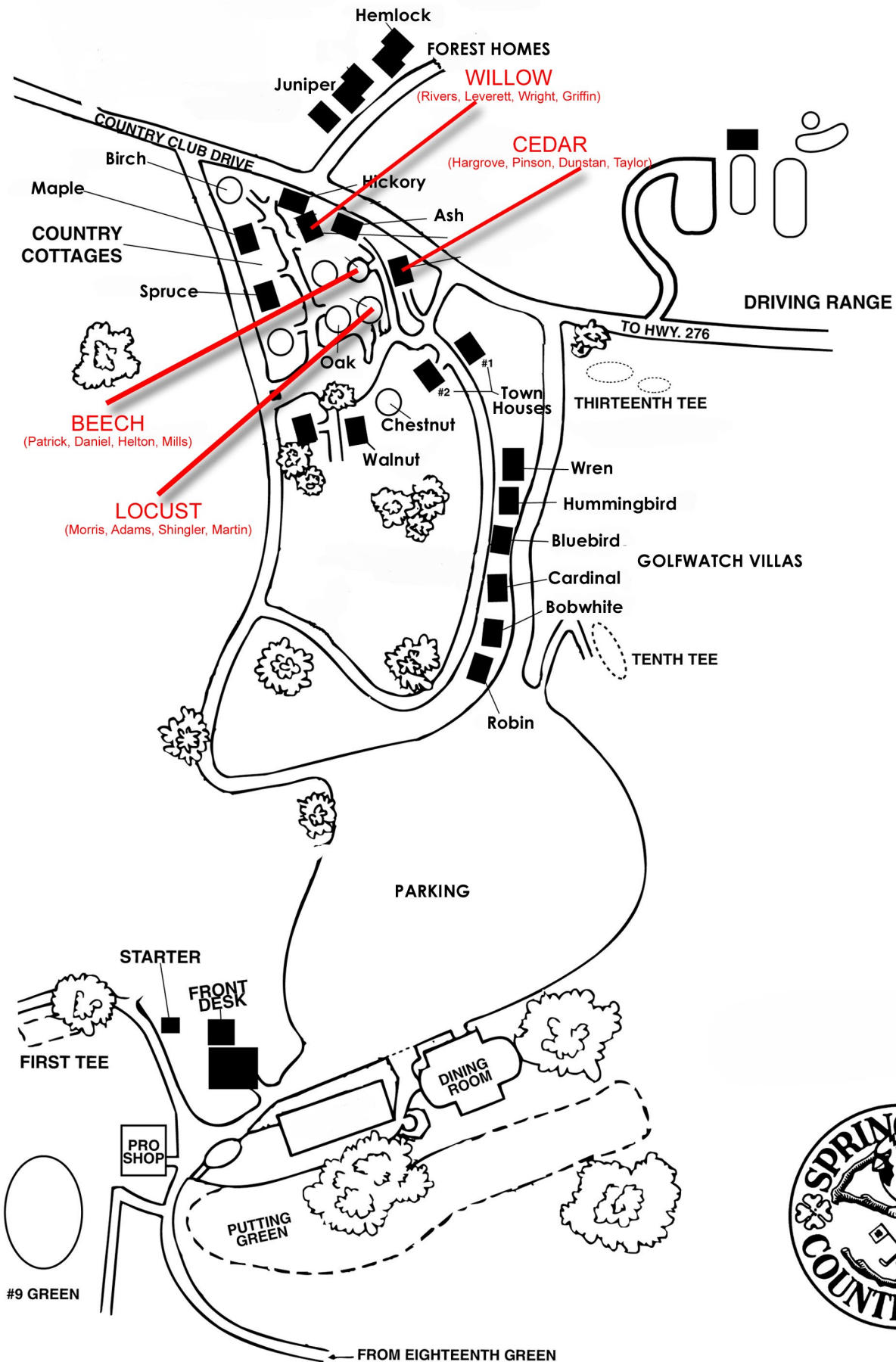

## 2012 STC CUP RULES SHEET



### **General**

The STC Cup is played in accordance with the USGA Rules Handbook.

All ruling must be discussed with opposing team and must be determined within the group before the hole is finished.

At anytime if local abnormal conditions interfere with the proper playing of the STC CUP, the Committee may considers it necessary to modify a Rule of Golf. (i.e. Course Conditions - Mud, Extreme Wetness, Poor Conditions)

**\*\*If for any reason a days play or session is cancelled, the STC Cup Committee has deemed Sunday after the Singles Match as the make up day. If for any reason a player can not compete in the Sunday make up match, the player(s) competitor(s) will receive a win.**

Tee off will be determined by “tee toss”, tee point to a particular team must tee off first.

**No Mulligan’s** will be played on the First Hole or any match during the STC Cup.

All balls must be in the cup unless concession(s) have been made.

All balls considered out of bounds (OB) must be re-teed unless the group has deemed the ball has crossed a hazard line (Red or Yellow).

A ball embedded “Plugged” in its own pitch-mark in the ground in any closely mown area through the green may be lifted, cleaned and dropped, without penalty, as near as possible to the spot where it lay but not nearer the hole. The ball when dropped must first strike a part of the course through the green. "Closely mown area" means any area of the course, including paths through the rough, cut to fairway height or less.

If for any reason a **Snake or Hillbilly** is hazardous to a player’s usual approach to a hole, the ball maybe moved to within a distance suitable to the playing competitor(s) no closer to the hole. If the ball is in a marked hazard and the player does not desire to play the ball due to a **Snake or Hillbilly**, the player/team will result in a one shot penalty and then can move the ball to a suitable location determined by the playing competitor(s) no closer to hole.

Playing the wrong ball will result in loss of hole.

Any player late for a tee time will be assessed a 3 hole penalty which will be considered loss of hole for team/individual.

Finished groups/individuals are prohibited from assisting teammates that are still in play. A teammate within the same group is the only player that can give assistance. (i.e. reading putts, yardage, pin locations). Captains are permitted to give advice to other groups but are not allowed to assist with reading putts.

Drinking alcohol and having the time of your life is mandatory, failure to do so will result in a shot to your manhood and the American spirit.

The Bet is \$100, to be paid by the losing team to his playing competitor of the Singles Match.

Below list a description of the formats and common rules violations for quick reference.

All range finders are approved even slope range finders

Players may ask their opponent to turn their radio down but at no time may a speaker, iLUV, radio etc. be turned off completely.

Official Tees to be played per match

Friday 4-Ball-White Tees

Saturday 4-Ball-Blue Tees

Saturday Alternate Shot- White Tees

Sunday Singles-Blue Tees

**Playoff-If the STC Cup ends in a tie, the following will apply. 2 players from each team will play a hole or holes until a winner is determine with full handicaps in place; the players will be determined by both captains. The format will be 4-Ball with handicaps according to tees being played.**

### **Local Rules**

The power lines on hole #2 is not an integral part of the golf course. If a player hits the power line, the player has two options 1) Play the ball as it lies after hitting the power line or re-tee.

All split rail fences located on golf course property will be treated as immovable obstructions.

## **Hole-In-One-Pot**

### Rules

Local hole in one rules apply.

Every player must pay \$20 per year to qualify.

If no participant has a hole in one the pot rolls over to the next year and all players must pay \$20 for that year. For example if the pot rolls over, 1st years payout \$320, 2nd \$640, 3rd year \$960, 4th year \$1280 and so on.

If a hole in one is made in the alternate shot format the participant with the hole in one has the option to split his earnings with his playing partner but it is not mandatory.

If a new player is added to the STC Cup and wants to participate in the Hole-In-One-Pot, he must become current with all prior years balance to win the entire pot, for example if next year a new player is added to the STC Cup group, he must put in \$40 instead of \$20.

If a player misses an STC Cup and wants to participate the following year, he must pay his balance and entry fee to get back into the pot and win the entire pot amount. Or the participant can pay the entry fee and only win the pot for that year and years to follow.

The pot is not paid out until the final day's competition is complete, if there is more than one hole in one in the same week the pot is split.

The pot after year one will be held in a separate bank account if no participant has a hole in one. Travis Wright will be the controlling authority of the account.

**Four-Ball (refer. USGA Section III, Rule 30)**

A competition in which two STC Cup teammates play as partners, each playing his own ball. The lower score of the partners is the score for the hole. If one partner fails to complete the play of the hole, there is no penalty.

STC Cup is a handicap match format; therefore the lower net score wins the hole.

**Alternate Shot (refer. USGA Section III, Rule 29)**

The alternate shot format is two golfers playing the same ball. One player drives the ball and the other hits the second shot. The players continue to alternate until the ball is in the hole. STC Cup Alternate Shot matches will be played with 8 participants (2 matches per group), groups will tee off in the order of match being played.

STC Cup Alternate Shot format is **Scotch Doubles**-Teams decide in advance who will drive the even holes and who will drive the odd holes (Thus, each player tees off on nine holes). Players alternate shots until the ball is in the hole.

STC Cup is a handicap match format; therefore the lower net score wins the hole.

Playing out of order will result in loss of hole. If deemed a team has continuously played out of order, all the holes that were played out of order will result in a loss per hole.

Team must play the same ball throughout the hole.

**Singles (refer. USGA Section III, Rule 2)**

STC Cup individual compete in match play head-to-head, a hole is won by the Individual that holes its ball in the fewer strokes.

STC Cup is a handicap match format; therefore the lower net score wins the hole.

**Only** teammate in the same group may assist another teammate throughout the Singles Match.
